There are no hidden add-ons, and all our options include the plot, burial, service and grave plaque.

In line with Shariah law, all graves at Eternal Gardens are uniform, natural and simple. All burial plots are in soft virgin ground and are raised to form a small mount which is covered with grass. All graves are aligned to face the direction of Mecca with beautifully simple plaques placed on top of graves.
